## RIO LINDA WATER DISTRICT Resolution No 6-84

Whereas, development in Sacramento County since the late 1940's has relied heavily on groundwater to supply its water needs, and, as a result, groundwater levels have declined steadily since that time; and

Whereas, State Department of Water Resources Bulletins 118-3 and 104-11 and the County-wide Water Plan developed cooperatively with the 24 major water utilities in the County recommended implementation of a conjunctive ground/surface water use program to stabilize groundwater levels; and

Whereas, these studies show that accelerating groundwater decline will lead to problems such as increased pumping costs and increased probability of subsidence, quality degradation and aquifer depletion;

Whereas, the most thorough documented argument for County-wide water resource management is the serious groundwater overdraft that has existed in the north, central and southern regions of the County, and

Whereas, in recognition of the serious groundwater overdraft situation and its attendant problems many of the water utilities in Sacramento County have developed plans and intend to convert from groundwater use to surface water supplies or augment present surface water supplies, and

Whereas, implementation of such plans will be costly to the customer of the water utilities and will benefit not only those customers but also users who choose to continue to pump groundwater and

Whereas, the benefit to groundwater users derives from the stabilization of groundwater levels resulting from the importation of surface water supplies, and

Whereas, that benefit to groundwater users is measurable and that benefit should be repaid to those who have paid for the surface water importation which created the benefit, and

Whereas, it is necessary to document the quantities and locations of groundwater extractions as well as of surface water supplies to

effectively manage the groundwater basin, and

Whereas, it is necessary to create a water advisory commission composed of persons knowledgeable in water matters to advise the Water Agency Board of Directors in such matters,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Rio Linda Water District agrees in concept to the amendments to the Sacramento County Water Agency Act to empower the Agency to manage the groundwater resources of the County and urges the Board of Directors of the Agency to authorize introduction of the amendments in the 1985 session of the State Legislature.
