BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that in the event that no petition for disapproval and veto of this ordinance be filed within the time required by law, or if such petition is filed and upon the election of the electors shall not disapprove and veto this ordinance, the Pfesident and Secretary of the Board of Directors of the RIO LINDA COUNTY WATER DISTRICT are authorized and directed to file certificates stating said facts and certified copies of this ordinance with the Secretary of State of the State of California and with the County Recorder of the County of Sacramento, being the County in which said District is located.
